- Two Discharge to Assess Teams (D2A)
- And three focused team: Learning Disability, Physical-sensory impairment and Older Adults Mental Health.

The Neighbourhood Teams undertake statutory Care Act Assessments, Care Act Reviews and Safeguarding Enquiries.

The teams is comprised of Social workers, Occupational Therapists and Community Support Workers.

Braintree Neighbourhood Teams

Neighbourhood working brings together social care, health providers, as well as voluntary organisations, around communities to improve the health and wellbeing of Braintree residents.

Teams use placed based working to ensure we work more jointly with our local partners. Some examples of how this happens:

- Supporting Independence Discussions
- GP Frailties and GP safeguarding meetings
- Mental Health MDT with EPUT
- Alignment of social care practitioners to residential and nursing care home providers (coming soon)
- Neighbourhoods Integration drop-ins with wider partners
- Social Prescriber's Carer's Drop-ins with ASC input etc.
