Background

Local Authorities constrained by central government funding allocations and their ability to raise funds locally.

Election uncertainty - highly doubtful significant sums will be afforded to Adult Social Care.

Adult Social Care must compete with other council services (potholes and children services etc.)

Sector needs more than £10bn to sustain services and invest in the future of adult social care for both working-age adults and those over the age of 65.



Decaffeination:

Falls are the biggest cause of death in older people, cost care providers a lot of time and money, and the NHS £4bn pa. **Care England and Stow Healthcare** led a voluntary solution for residents to remove or reduce caffeinated drinks from their diets which saw falls related to toileting reduce by 35%. (Initial initiative led by NHS UHL)

Additional Benefits (Cornerstone Healthcare Group) – not yet published saw:

- Behaviour significant improvements, reduction in challenging behaviour, resident on staff
- **Skin Integrity** improvement noticed by staff, pressure injury down
- Continence slight decreased reliance on aids
- Sleep significant improvement in sleep linking to improved behaviours

Procurement:

An estimated saving of circa £49 per resident week could be saved though a review of the way in which goods and services are procured equating to a 5.4% uplift on an average £950 weekly care fee (SF/NHS/LA):

 - Energy lowest cost of energy for the care sector guaranteed (Av. 27% saving)
 - Insurance 10% underwriter discount for association members
 - Catering 10-14% savings delivered through volume leverage and same quality subs
 - Agency 5-10% cost reduction
