### **Immunisations**

#### **Residents / Clients / Patients**

- Seasonal **flu** immunisation (over 65 or long-term condition, care home resident, carers in receipt of carers allowance)
- COVID-19 immunisation (over 75 or care home resident for older adults, immunosuppressed over 6 months old)
- Pneumococcal immunisation (one does once 65 or older)
- RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus) (on turning 75, catch-up for those 75 to 79)

#### Staff

- Seasonal flu immunisation (all frontline social care and health staff)
- If pregnant (in addition to seasonal flu immunisation)
  - RSV immunisation (from 28 weeks of pregnancy)
  - Whooping cough (pertussis) immunisation

## **Preparation**

#### **Standard Operation Procedures (SOP) and Business Continuity Plans**

- Arrange immunisations
- Record keeping:
  - Residents' vaccination status, medicines, chronic illnesses (e.g. chronic renal failure)
  - Staff vaccination status
- Visiting arrangement
- Staff training (including infection prevention & control)
- When and how to report an outbreak and who does it

#### **Outbreak plan**

- How to manage an outbreak of respiratory or gastrointestinal infections
- Resident isolation, cohorting
- Staff cohorting
- Visiting arrangement (professional and love ones)
