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What is a DSCR System

A DSCR system allows the digital recording of care information and care received an individual within a social care setting, replacing traditional paper records.

Assured systems are person-centred and enable information to be shared securely and in real-time with authorised individuals across the health and care sector

Other systems are available, but aren't currently eligible for grant funding.

Benefits of a DSCR System

- Simpler creation of care plans
- Reduction in time spent on paperwork
- Improved data quality
- Increased involvement in adults and families in care
- Reduction in stationary costs
- CQC see DSCR as an example of good and outstanding care

The Grant Funding Programme

Essex County Council will fund 50% of providers first year implementation costs, up to a maximum of £10,000 (this is being reviewed by NHS). As long as:

- Your registered CQC Location is within Essex (including Southend and Thurrock)
- You did not have a DSCR system prior to 1st April 2022.
- You adopt a system from the <u>NHS Assured Supplier List</u>.
