Review of the Essex employment, training, skills, procurement, and business needs to deliver ambitions of the ECAC and partners in relation to innovative and green construction for a carbon zero future

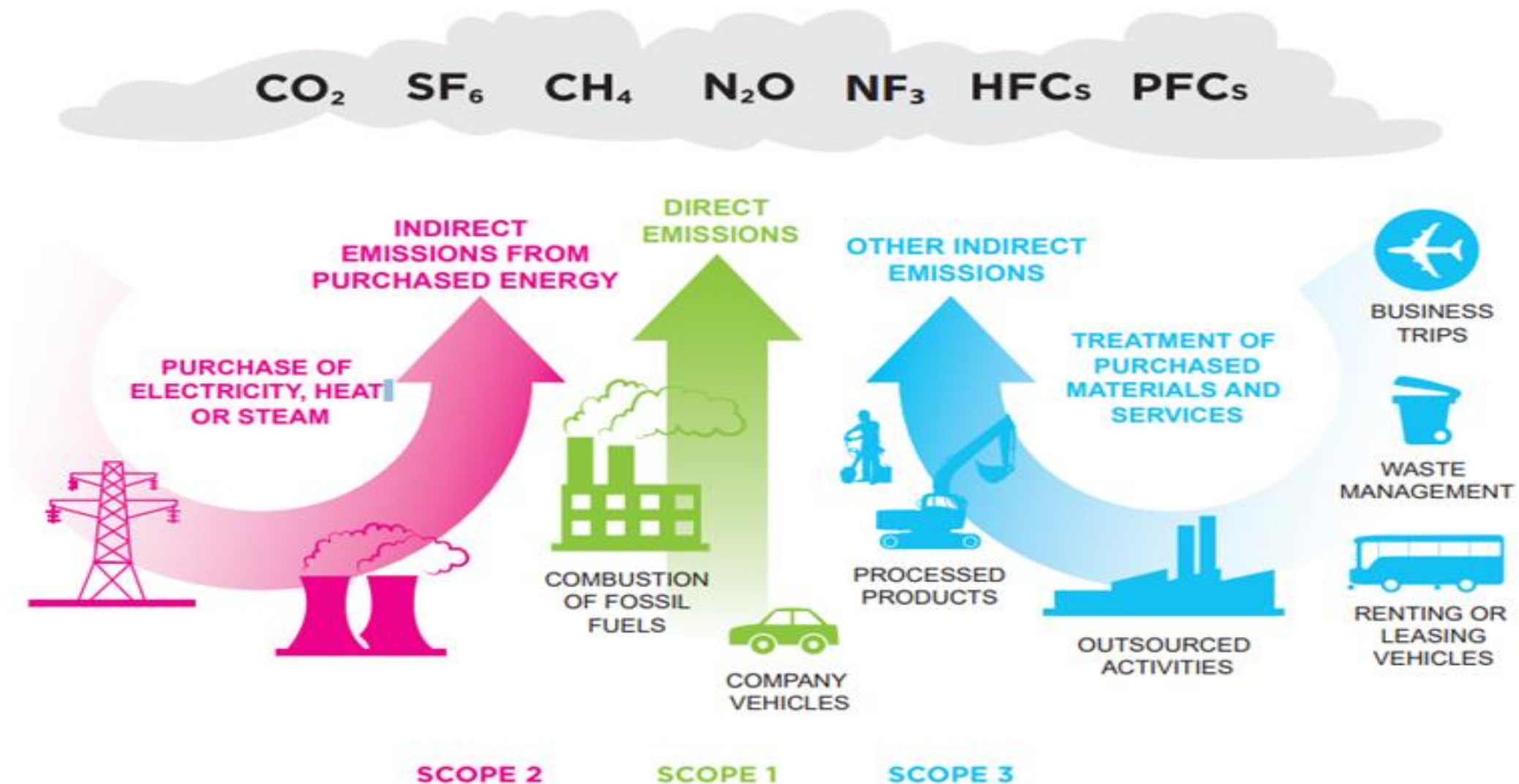


The [housing] industry needs to secure sustainable building materials with an urgent focus on green procurement standards in place by end of 2022.
