## FRIDAY 26 MAY

- Ford RideLondon Classique Stage 1
  - UCI Women's WorldTour Professional road race - Saffron Walden to Colchester - 150km
  - **Start 11:00 / Finish 14:45** (average speed. 40kph / 25mph)

## SATURDAY 27 MAY

- Ford RideLondon Classique Stage 2
  - UCI Women's WorldTour Professional road race - Maldon to Maldon - 140km
  - **Start 11:00 / Finish 14:30** (average speed. 40kph / 25mph)

## SUNDAY 28 MAY

- Ford RideLondon-Essex
  - 100/60/30-mile routes for 25,000 registered amateur participants
  - 65 Miles of the mass participation route in Essex using the same route as 2022
  - **Start 06:00 to 09:30 St. James's Park & Westminster / Finish 10:00 to 18:30 Southwark**

## WHAT TO EXPECT

- 120 Elite female athletes racing at an average speed of 25mph
- Escort by police motorcycles, race officials, team support cars and race medical services
- Changes to the routes used in 2022, the race passes on the route in c. 10-15 minutes
- Emergency services take absolute priority

## IMPACT

- Very local road closures at start and finish venues to set-up event infrastructure
- Temporary road closures along the race route for 15-20 minutes

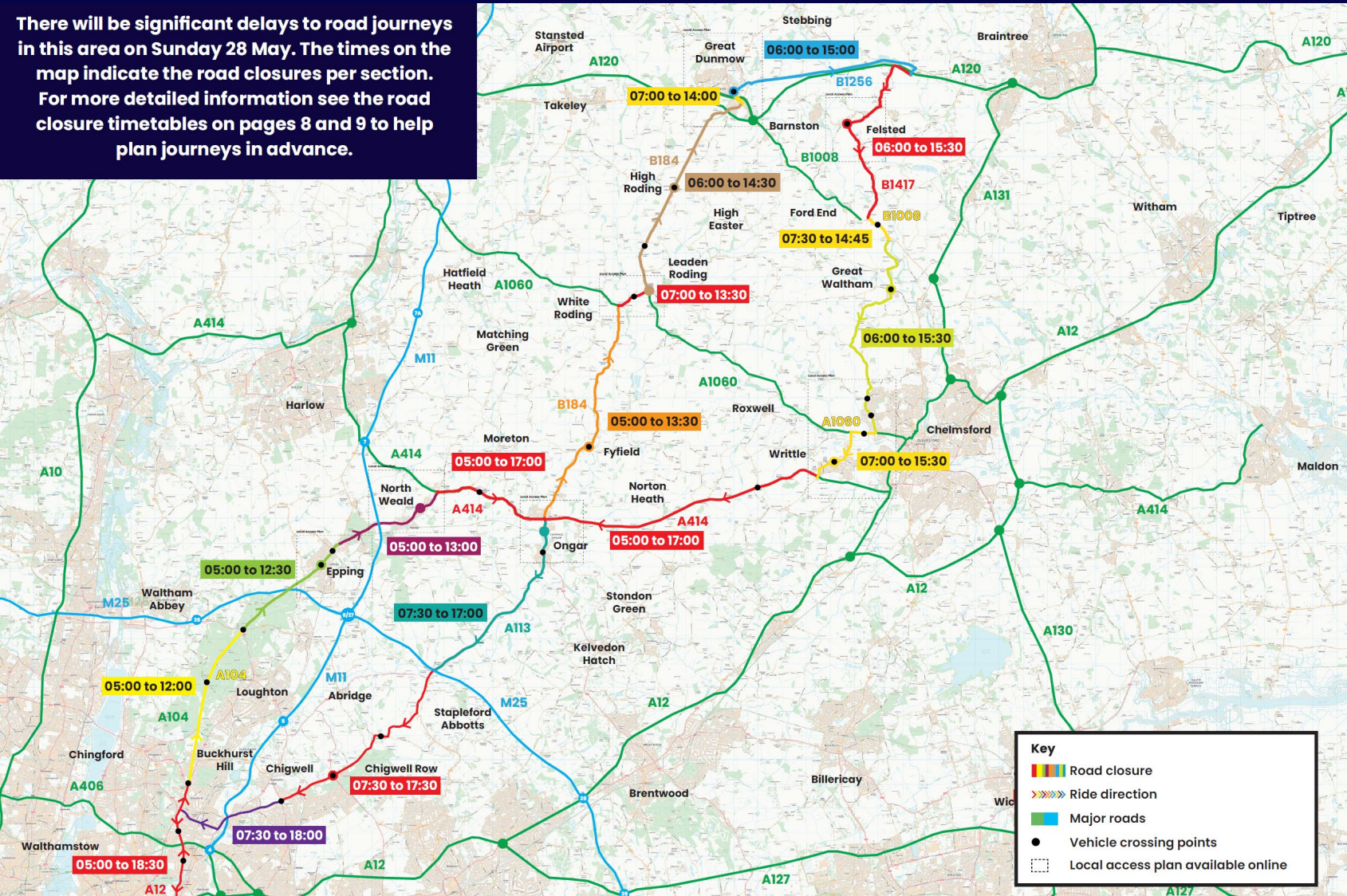
## FRIDAY 26 MAY 2023 – STAGE 1

- Local road closures in Saffron Walden town centre 5am to 1pm
- Local road closures in eastern area of Colchester city centre 5am to 8pm
- Temporary road closures between Saffron Walden and Colchester during 10am – 3pm

## SATURDAY 27 MAY 2023 – STAGE 2

- Local road closures in Maldon town centre 5am to 8pm
- Temporary road closures around Maldon, Tiptree and Little Baddow during 10am – 3pm

There will be significant delays to road journeys in this area on Sunday 28 May. The times on the map indicate the road closures per section. For more detailed information see the road closure timetables on pages 8 and 9 to help plan journeys in advance.



## WHAT TO EXPECT

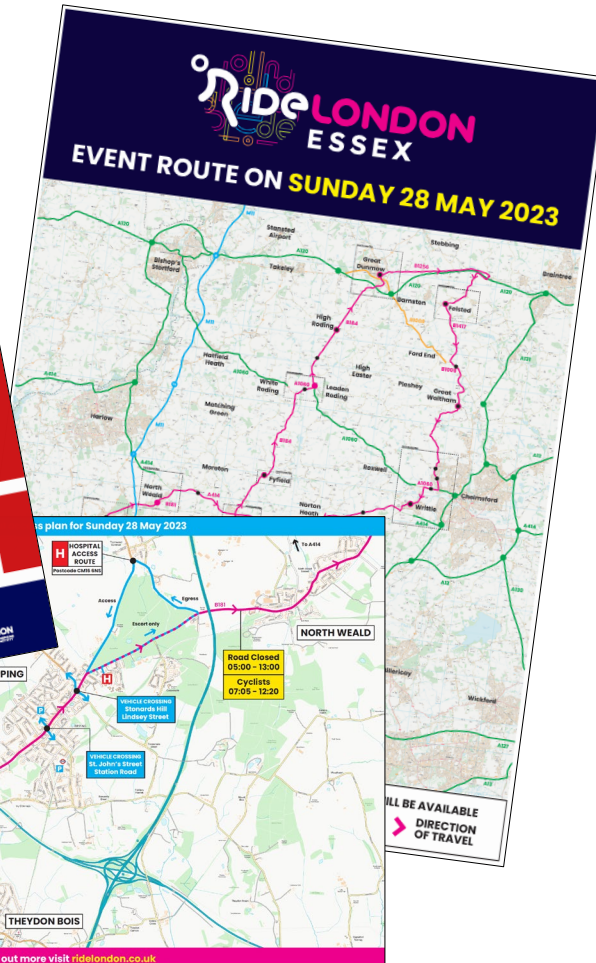
- 25,000 Amateur riders passing for several hours
- The route uses 65 miles of Essex highway
- Same route as 2022

## IMPACT

- Extended road closures along the ride route

## SUNDAY 28 MAY 2023

- Emergency services take absolute priority
- Phased road closures
- Vehicle Crossing Points
- Local Access Plans with access times
- Wide public communications & awareness



## HOW CAN WE ASSIST WITH PLANNING?

- Detailed road closure leaflets
- Detailed maps and plans to link areas
- Event routes and timings
- Online information & direct contact
- Vehicle Crossing Point access
- Dedicated Provider Workshop
  - Assist planning to minimise the impact
  - Identify visits requiring more detail with existing access
  - Filter visits that will require a specific plan
- Event Control Room helpdesk support on the day
