

Hospital passports for adults with a Learning Disability

- The hospital passport is designed to give hospital staff helpful information that isn't only about illness and health.
- The passport can include lists of individual likes and dislikes. This might be about the amount of physical contact a person is ok with, or their favourite type of drink, as well as their interests.
- The passport helps all the hospital staff know how to make an individual feel comfortable.
- If an individual goes into hospital, their hospital passport should go with them. The passport tells the doctors and nurses that they should make a copy and put the copy in the hospital notes.
- The template below is the standard NHS template and each CCG area will adapt it with their own branding.
- Whilst some hospitals will insist on the hospital passport being in this format most hospitals will accept a bespoke document as long as it covers the required areas.
