
We can support you to build your skills offer through a number of initiatives including mentoring, apprenticeships and Kickstart.



Introduction



Entry to work routes in ECC







- Apprenticeships are a way to gain skills, knowledge and work experience. They combine work, training, and study, letting you 'earn while you learn'
- Anybody can be an apprentice in almost any profession regardless of age or level of study
- An apprentice can be a new entrant into an organisation, or an employee who is upskilling or retraining
- There are four levels of apprenticeships from intermediate to degree level.
- There are a wide range of apprenticeships covering 1500 job roles

- Any organisation with a payroll of more than £3m pay an Apprenticeship levy of 0.5% of their pay bill. This levy is used to pay for the cost of apprenticeship training.
- There are levy paying organisations within Essex who are not fully utilising their funds and every year millions are returned to the treasury unspent!
- Apprenticeship levy-paying employers can transfer a maximum of 25% of their annual funds to SME employers looking for funding to pay the full cost of their apprenticeship training without the need to pay the 5% co-investment cost.

Timpson's as a large national levy paying organisation have funded the apprenticeship training for 5 employees at Bloomsbury Homecare in Tendring.

KICKSTART SCHEME

- A £2bn fund to create high quality 6-month work placements for young people
- Placements are fully funded for 25 hours per week, plus NI contributions
- A grant is paid to employers to cover training for young people
- This is a voluntary scheme for young people, who will be referred by DWP
- Young people are aged 16-24 years and will be unemployed or at risk of being so
- The scheme will operate until December 2021
- The Kickstart Essex Scheme run by ECC is estimated to provide £14K social value per placement and our target is 500 placements during the project lifespan



How to participate?

Employers with more than 30 placements to offer can apply directly to DWP

Employers with fewer than 30 placements can go via a DWP Kickstart Gateway or apply directly

Essex County Council is operating as a DWP

Gateway

Our project is called Kickstart Essex

Kickstart Essex is currently closed to new applications due to high demand, but there is a chance we will reopen in the future.









Essex Opportunities Portal Statistics

Virtual Jobs and Apprenticeships Fair

- We had an extremely successful virtual jobs fair in partnership with the Jobs Live platform on July 7th with 33 employers and training providers presenting and 3560 people viewing the event.
- Target audience; school leavers, NEET group, unemployed adults and those seeking a career change
- Employers included; Athona, BUPA, Essex County Council, Galliford Try, Investment 2020, Knight Group, Princess Alexandra and Rose Builders – to name but a few!

Mentor Me Programme

We are working in partnership with the Youth Group to offer 2000 free mentoring sessions to Young People aged 16-24 across Essex.

This will equate to between 400 and 500 young people receiving between 4 and 5 free mentoring sessions with industry experts.
