Hello from **Paul** & **Simon**! Your Leads for Integrated Neighbourhoods in Mid Essex.




It's now been 1 month since the 3rd of our 3 initial stakeholder workshops, where we began the process of developing our *Integrated Neighbourhood Approach*.

Over the course of the 3 workshops we worked with over **100 partners** to understand the strengths & assets within the system and the ambition for integrated neighbourhoods. The insights of partners allowed us to develop a **shared vision**, **mission**, **values & principles** for the *Integrated Neighbourhood Approach* in Mid Essex. A draft was shared at the 3rd workshop and feedback gathered. Below is version 2, which incorporates the feedback.

In developing these we must ensure that the boundaries are not only recognised by the people that live and work in them, but also incorporate the unique needs of the different populations of Mid Essex. No mean feat, but watch this space!
