


Connection to dementia groups & Side by Side within local communities




Tips for making a home dementia-friendly

How Dementia Support works



After a self or external referral a Dementia Adviser should contact them within a week

Referrals into dementia support

- Quick and Easy
- Online portal – DofB, name, address and contact number & reason for referral
- People receive telephone support within 5 days
- Will be referred down to community support if needed
- Keeping It Touch calls (KiT) helps us keep in contact with vulnerable people


